We offer two programs of study: School of Correspondence and School of Online Education. Calvary Chapel Bible College Distance Learning is a non-denominational, unaccredited, religiously exempt institution that offers a Bachelor's degree in Biblical Studies (B.B.S.) and an Associate's degree in Theology (A.Th.). In addition to our degree programs, a Certificate of Completion and an Audit program are offered. If you have difficulty obtaining the proof of education needed to enroll into either of the degree programs you may opt to enter into the Certificate of Completion Program. This program is identical to those that offer degrees in that the curriculum is the same. The only true difference is the certificate awarded at the end.

Our mission is to train Christian men and women to handle and communicate the inerrant and infallible written Word of God, which leads to a life that reflects a personal commitment to Jesus Christ. 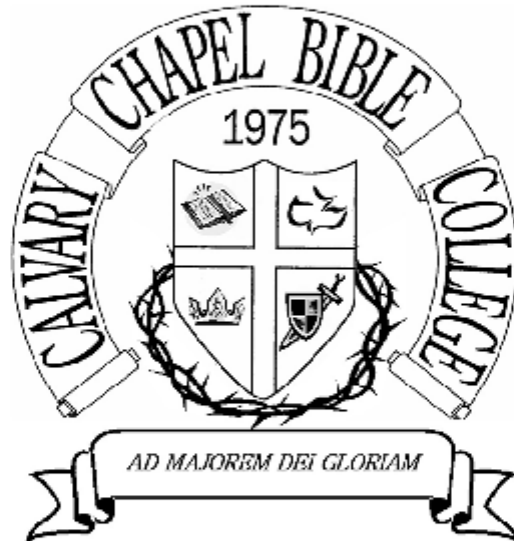
